I had the immense pleasure of meeting Mr. John Pine today when he delivered a check for \$2,500.00 from the National Italian Invitational Golf Tournament for Charities to the Orlando Union Rescue Mission. I am nearly speechless with gratitude for your generosity. Your thoughtfulness will help transform the lives of our guests – the formerly homeless men, women, and children who live with us at the Mission.

The Mission provides long-term residential programs for the homeless. We operate two facilities: our Men's Home, where we host 120 single men every night, and our Family Home, where we currently serve 134 single women, single moms, single dads, and intact couples with children. Sixty-eight of the Family Home guests are kids seventeen years and under.

We provide, free of charge, the housing, food, education, addiction recovery, counseling, and other assistance to equip our guests for permanent independence and self-sufficiency. We accept no government funding; we rely on the generosity of people like you and the NII to provide the resources our guests need so they can support themselves and their families for the rest of their lives. You and other donors enable them to escape homelessness forever.

We will use your gift to ensure the children here have a merry Christmas. Your kindness will supply all the kids who live with us gifts that will permit them to forget their plight and celebrate the holiday just like other children. One of our goals is to protect our guests from the hopelessness that can accompany homelessness. You have made sure Christmas for the Mission children this year will be filled with joy and hope. God bless you and your colleagues.
